1 CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Kevin Kahoot called the Meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

2 ROLL CALL

4.1 Gerald Kleist and/or Ursula DeKeyser

- Report to Council on Nuclear Waste Community Committee (NWCC) Activities

Gerald Kleist advised that the Nuclear Waste Administrative Assistant, Michelle Briska had resigned from the position and that the position has been posted.

The Committee has utilized their Administrative Support Program funding allocation of \$35,000 and have requested their second instalment of funds from the Nuclear Waste Management Organization (NWMO).

The second group of community members completed a trip to Toronto to Learn More about the NWMO's Site Selection Process. The attendees advised that they learned a lot about the process. One of the participants shared her thoughts about the trip with members of the community at a local event and the NWCC provided a donation to the event in her name as recognition of this announcement.

Kids-Need-A-Ride organized a pizza party, on behalf of the Committee, as a way to engage and inform local youth about the NWMO's Site Selection Process. The turnout was quite good, with parents and youth in attendance. The questions that they raised demonstrated curiosity in the process, and tended to be asked informally through discussion with NWMO staff and

Committee members rather than during the formal presentation. The Chair and Co-Chair of Kids-Need-A-Ride have advised that they are willing to assist the Committee in organizing future youth events.

The NWCC and the NWMO both had booths at the 2013 Family Safety Night. The NWCC booth was staffed by the Nuclear Waste Administrative Assistant and Committee Members who collected email addresses from members of the community. The email addresses will be utilized to send information about the Committee's events as well as the community's process.

The NWCC held a dinner meeting to brainstorm some new ideas. The Committee will be holding an event on July 1st, in coordination with Canada Day festivities, to engage the community. The Committee's youth member has been extremely helpful in this process.

The placemats created by the Committee are not being used at this point, but will be updated later in the year for use by local restaurants.

The Committee's next newsletter is under development and will soon be distributed to the community.

Council thanked Gerald for his attendance at the Meeting and the increased level of communication between the Committee and Council.

4.2 Jenny Cowie, Recreation Committee Chair

- Recreation Committee Update

The Committee is working on membership recruitment in order to have more volunteers to assist with local community events. Jenny advised that if they are able to get more Committee members that they will reopen the discussion on which Committee member will be the Chair.

 - Will be held over the Summer on Mondays from 7:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. (weather permitting).
 - There were sixteen (16) people out this past Monday.

- Great to see so many people involved in volleyball, and at the Waterfront Park.

- Eagle Days – June 28th, 29th, 30th and July 1st
 - Friday, June 28th
 - Glow Ball at the Golf Course – 10:00 p.m.
 - Saturday, June 29th
 - ATV Derby – registration at the Legion at 10:00 a.m.; starts at 11:00 a.m.
 - Family Movie night – 6:30 p.m. at the Recreation Centre with the movie starting at 7:00 p.m.
 - Sunday, June 30th
 - Pancake Breakfast at the Seniors Centre.
 - Best Ball Golf at the Golf Course – starts at 12:00 p.m.
 - Monday, July 1st – Canada Day
 - There are a lot of local groups having activities, so the Recreation Committee is going to focus on having Beach Volleyball at the Waterfront Park.

- Minor Sports – T-Ball / Baseball and Soccer
 - Could not find soccer coaches so the Committee won't be running soccer in the Spring, but will be running it in the Fall
 - The Committee has two great coaches (Amy Rolfe and Shannon Jefferies) that are running T-Ball and Baseball. They've had a really good turn-out

- Recreation Summer Student
 - The student will primarily be responsible for court sports but the Committee will also be developing some activities for the student to run at other locations such as the Waterfront Park.

Jenny requested that Council increase the number of Recreation Committee Members to ensure that additional people could participate and assist with various events and activities.

Council advised that they were pleased to see the Committee functioning well. Thanks for all your help and enthusiasm! Council cautioned on the Committee membership getting too big because it might be difficult to get quorum for Meetings.

approximately 1500 m of road grade be built at a width of 24 feet. This should be topped with a width of 20 feet of gravel. The grade could initially be built to access all the lots, but only have gravel applied to access the first 3 lots. As lots are purchased, additional gravel could be added to extend the road to access other properties.

Council concurred that the cost of any road development should be included in the cost of selling the properties that abut the road.

Council discussed amendments to the survey to:

- Straighten the road to remove a majority of the last 200 metres.
- Include an easement at the end of the road for drainage

Council requested that the Township get a quote for the development of this road as per these requirements.

Councillor Robinson left the Meeting at this point.
