PROCESS FOR SELLING OF PAVING STONES

The Process is as Follows:

1. a) There are eleven (11) lots of red paving stone available and eleven (11) lots of white paving stones available.
b) The price per lot (\$250.00 for 500 paving stones) with a maximum number of lots per person set at 5. If additional lots are desired, and no other interested parties have come forward by 4:00 p.m. on the date specified, the process will be repeated the following day.
c) The Municipal Office will begin taking offers on Wednesday, May 13th, 2009 at 9:00 a.m.
d) The timeframe for picking up the paving stones from the Public Works Yard – two (2) weeks from the date of purchase.
e) Individuals are advised to talk to Perry Dyck, Public Service & Operations Supervisor prior to the date chosen to make an offer, if they would like to inspect the paving stones.
f) There will be no refunds / returns of paving stones after payment is received.
g) Public Works Staff will **not** assist the purchaser with picking up of the paving stones.
2. The Municipal Office has a tally sheet listing the number of lots (by colour of paving stone).
3. Interested parties can come to the Municipal Office on Wednesday, May 13th, 2009 at 9:00 a.m. and will be handled on a first come - first served basis.
4. In the event that multiple people are at the office at the same time, specified cards will be drawn to determine who has first opportunity to purchase lots. High card will pick first. Aces are high.
5. Payment may be made by cash, debit, credit card or cheque. Post-dated cheques will not be accepted.
6. Arrangements for date and time of picking up of the paving stones to be made with Perry Dyck.
7. Receipts will be issued and must be presented to Perry Dyck in order to pick up the paving stones.
8. If paving stones are not picked up within the two (2) week timeframe, one letter of notice will be sent to the purchaser to advise them of a seven-day window in which they may pick up the stones. If, following this timeframe, the stones have still not been picked up; they will be re-advertised for sale, following the same process.
